- A big performance at MPA is this Saturday, March 9 at Lake Mary High School. Our Concert Band performs at 10:00 am and Symphonic Band performs at 1:30 pm.
- State MPA is tentatively scheduled for April 25-April 27. We will select the date which does not conflict with Prom.
- The Spring Concert will be on May 7, 2019
- Our Band Banquet will be on May 11, 2019
